  - Feedback on the event
  - It is a significant investment - did it result in value for money?
  - Would the school consider this in the future
- Kalahari fundraiser review:
  - Sold 915 tickets raising \$9,150 although multiple cases where teachers "found" orders after deadline and we were able to secure an additional 22 tickets from Kalahari raising a further \$220.
  - Total raised: \$9,370
  - For next year should consider:
    - Extending period - suggest providing 2 weeks before thanksgiving and third week after to remind and chase before orders due
    - Adjustment process and/or instructions to staff to avoid these last minute 'lost' orders
    - Consider process for validating and approving order value and payment - should include more than one person and document all order on a spreadsheet
    - Create volunteer opportunities for reviewing and completing orders
- Search for a new president and treasurer
  - Urgently need to fill Nominations sub-committee chair
